Preferred Qualifications:

The successful candidate will assist and guide the architectural and fundraising teams to support the planned Library expansion. Experience with capital projects, including fundraising campaigns, is preferred.

The starting salary range for this full-time, 40-hour/week position is \$65,000-\$73,000 per annum, commensurate with experience. The position may require some nights and weekends.
